Worship Center Renovation

- 1) As we move forward in the renovation process, there will be a special offering taken this Sunday, July 18. - 2) Beginning Sunday, July 25, morning worship services will be held in our Family Life Center. There will be no Sunday evening services during the renovation. We will do our best to make this room as appropriate and comfortable as possible. Please continue to worship in reverence by not bringing drinks or food into the Family Life Center during worship services. Here are some things to consider regarding our worship services:
 - The gym floor is considered a rubber sports floor and ladies especially should be careful in their selection of shoes worn as some may damage the floor. Restrooms are available in the gym, but they are small. The restrooms in the AMC and the large restrooms in the CMC will also be available. The restrooms around the worship center will not be available as they will be involved in the renovation.
 - Anyone interested in any of the pews must claim them by Friday, July 16. Pews will need to be removed by Wednesday, July 21.
 - Volunteers with strong backs are needed for the week of July 19-23. We will begin each morning at 9:00 and work until 9:00 PM. The whole worship center has to be cleared for the contractors to start on July 26. We will also need to set up the Family Life Center for our worship services.
